Communities and Leisure Sub Committee meeting held on the 27th January 2023 at 11.00AM

5. LUF- Empire complex and Shelters

The Town Clerk explained that with the LUF bid being successful for the town the plans to extend the play centre and renovate the shelters will be completed. The work is expected to take up to 26 weeks for the empire project to be completed and the shelters up to 16 weeks. All bids involved in the LUF for the town will be looking holding a public event at the town hall where members of the community are welcome to attend to view the plans and designs for all parties involved.
